

RFI, II and Student Aid Q Ended December 31, 2020

Keene State University's Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Aid to Students. The University signed and assigned an agreement to apply for the CARES Act, CRRSAA, and ARP Funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) for financial aid grants to students.

As of April 24, 2020, the University received a total of \$1,100,000 in COVID-19 funds designated for distribution to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act, CRRSAA and ARP.

As of December 31, 2020, the University has distributed a total of \$324,603.99 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

As of December 31, 2020, TU received a total of \$378,260.

The program is administered under Section 484 in Title 18 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus is subject to the provisions of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and the Higher Education Act of 1992. The program is administered under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act, CRRSAA, and ARP as follows:
