Capt Evita Armstrong is the Recruiting Officer, Education Officer, and Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies of Air Force ROTC Detachment 015 located at Tuskegee University, Alabama. Capt Armstrong enlisted in the United States Air Force in December 2009.
