Lt Col Jason M. Newcomer is the Commander, Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps Detachment 015, Tuskegee University, Tuskegee, AL. He is the Department Chair and Professor of Aerospace Studies and leads a cadre of instructors and support staff that develops the cadet corps. He and his team are responsible for the recruitment, training, and commissioning of high-quality cadets to develop into leaders in tomorrow's Air and Space forces.

Lt Col Newcomer entered active duty in 1998 through Basic Military Training at Lackland AFB, TX as an Aircraft Maintenance Apprentice on the E-4B National Airborne Operations Center and later commissioned through the Reserve Officer Training Corps program. Prior to his current assignment, he was the Associate Dean of Education and a Deputy Department Chair at the Air Command and Staff College, Maxwell AFB, AL, where he led the development of over 500 field grade officer graduate students from all branches of the U.S. military and allied nations. He has also served on both the Air Staff at the Pentagon, and as a staff officer and operations chief in the directorate of operations at U.S. Cyber Command.
